The **CDC** offers family support programs, infant development, prenatal classes, breastfeeding support and connections, infant massage and baby development groups.

Programs:

- Early Years Services: Drop In
- Family Support Program (Child, youth and parenting): Provides services to children and families by engaging children and youth in socio-recreational activities and supporting the parents' ability to provide adequate care for their children. Referral required from the Ministery of Children and Familiy Development for a child care worker.
- Occupational Therapy: Offered to children from birth to 5 years of age assisting with activities of daily living such as playing learning, feeding, and dressing.
- **Physiotherapy:** Promotes physical development and movement in children from birth to 5 years of age.
- Also offers a variety of other programs such as Preschool, Speech and Language Therapy, Supported Child Development, Prenatal classes and so much more.

<u>Child Health Clinics:</u> Immunizations and Child Development, dental assessments, speech and language pathology

<u>Nurse-Family Partnerhsip:</u> This free program offers support for women who are under 24 years of age and are less than 29 weeks pregnant with their first baby. If you enroll, the public health nurse will visit you in your home or wherever you are comfortable, starting in pregnancy and continuing until your baby is 2 years old.

Cariboo midwives are a team of midwives who provide primary care to the people of the Cariboo during pregnancy, birth, and the weeks following the birth.

The midwives provide plenty of time to discuss options in pregnancy and birth and enjoy getting to know each client and their family. The midwives offer blood tests, ultrasounds, and other standard testing throughout the childbearing year. Midwives also offer postpartum care (care in the days and weeks following the birth) including home visits in the first days to anybody in the Williams Lake area if they had a physician for the pregnancy and birth. Midwives are paid by MSP and are therefore free to BC residents.
